ALLOW WeldQ POP-UPS



OVERVIEW

The AWCR provides a national framework for qualifying and testing welders to standards such as AS/NZS ISO 9606-1 and AS/NZS 2980, and other welding standards where specified.

It:

- ✓ Allows qualified welders to be registered so as to be able to work on any site without further testing resulting in a significant cost saving to industry.
- ✓ Provides industry with easy access to a database of welders with up to date certification and details of their career history.
- ✓ Generates data for a skills gap analysis which will allow the development of a detailed suite of training initiatives to upskill the workforce.
- ✓ Runs on the **WeldQ** platform; a fully internet enabled cloud based system with a supporting mobile app.

GETTING STARTED

To enable Pop-ups in Google's *Chrome* browser to allow **WeldQ** to access all features, please follow the following step by step instructions:

- ✓ Click on the setting tabs (3 vertical dots on the right of screen)
- ✓ Scroll down to *Settings* in the bottom of the pup-up windows and click on it.
- ✓ Click on *Settings* and a *Settings* tab opens in Chrome
- ✓ Scroll to the bottom of the page to **+Show advanced settings** and click on this link
- ✓ Scroll to the *Privacy* tab and click on the grey button *Content settings...*
- ✓ On the window that opens, scroll to *Pop-ups*
- ✓ If the radio button is marked *Allow all sites to show pop-ups(not recommended)*, no further action is required, otherwise click on the grey *Manage exceptions ...* button
- ✓ In the window that opens, click on the empty box and add <https://wtia.weld.com> and hit the *Enter* key on the keyboard.
- ✓ Click on the grey *Finished* button to close each open window.
- ✓ Restart *Chrome*

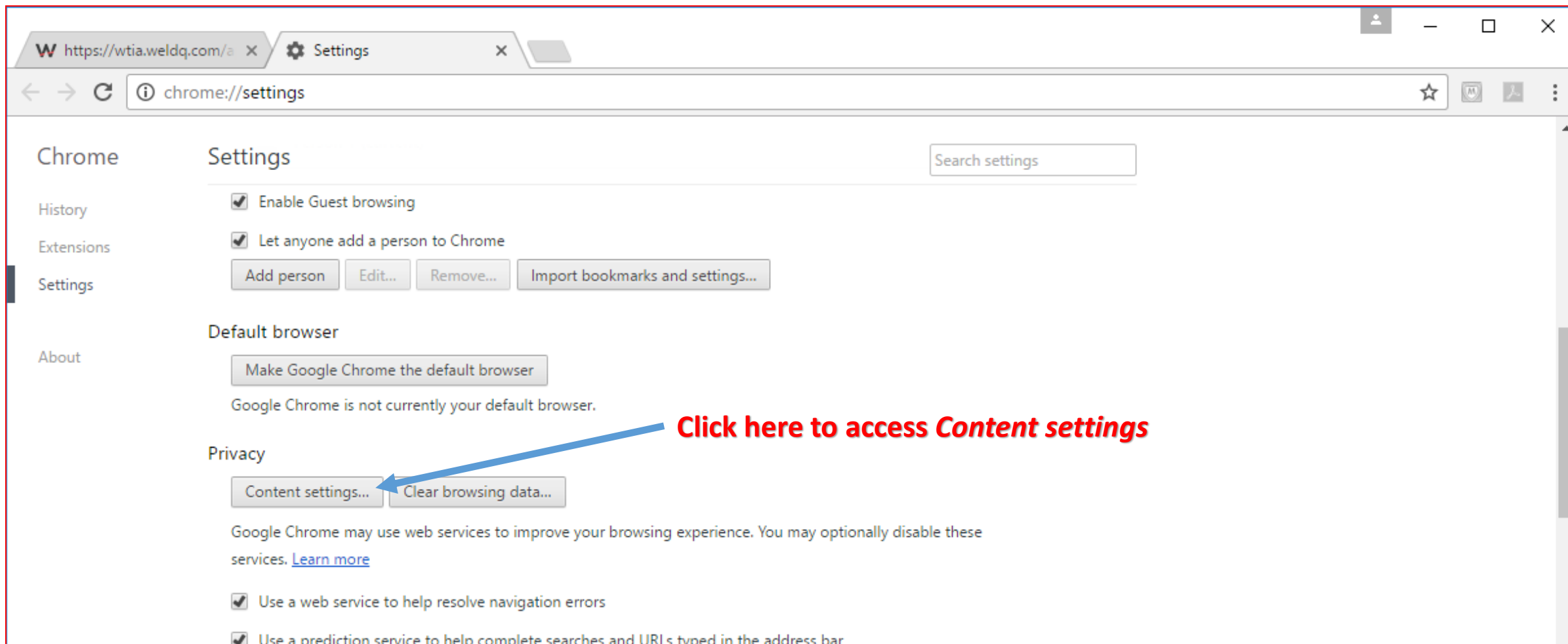

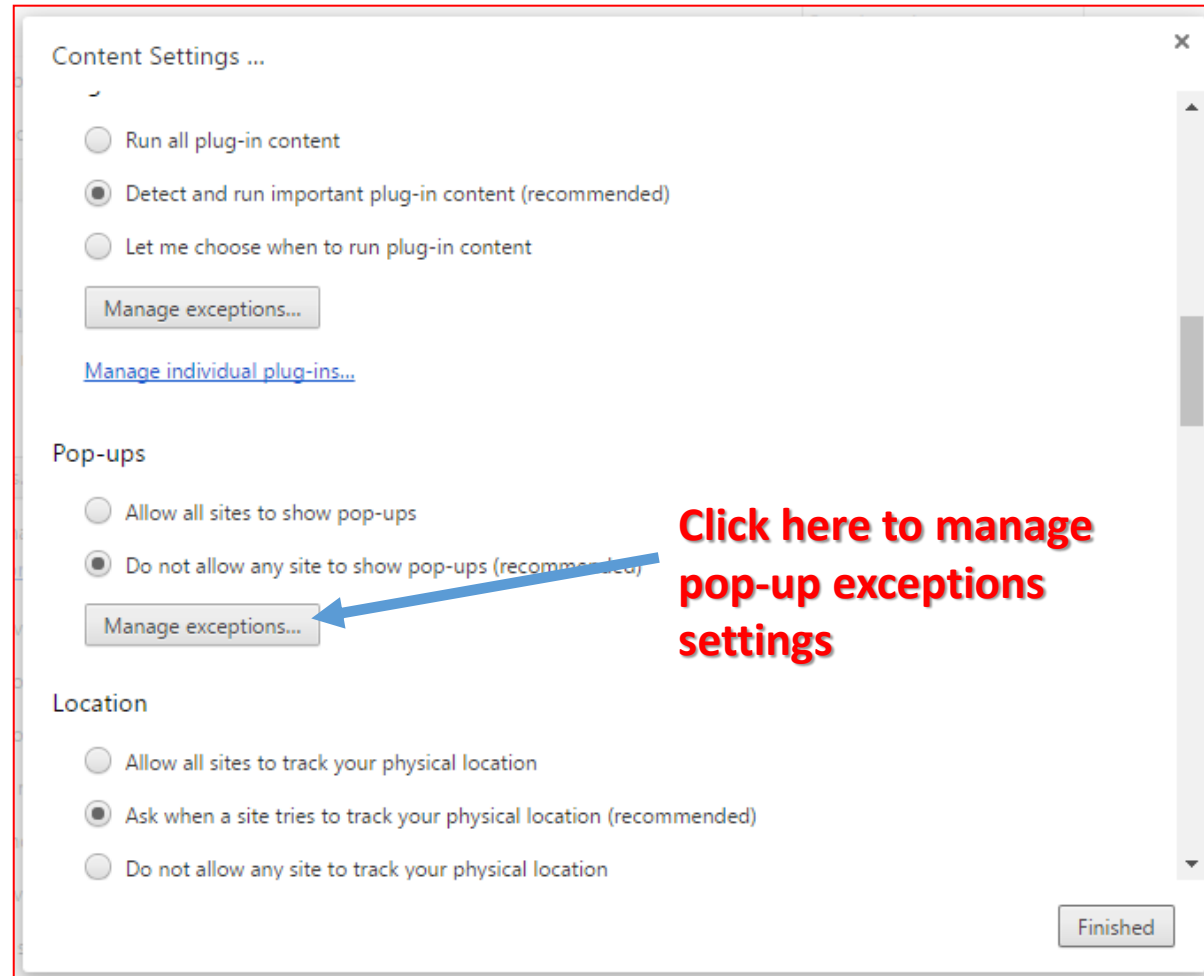


